COMPETITION SECTION SECTION BRAVISSIMO

ELIGIBILITY

All dancers must be amateurs.

AGE

Age as of 31 December 2025. For groups of more than one person, age is calculated based on the group average. Our age categories: 6–9 years old | 10–12 years old | 13–15 years old | 16+ | Adults 25+

CLASSIFICATION | AGE DIVISION

NOVICE

Dancer who is just starting out. Little or no competition or performance experience.

Example:

- Dancers who have never competed or have only competed once.
- Dancers who have 1-2 years or less experience.

PRE-COMPETITIF

Dancers who have little competition experience and are at the beginner level. Technique and execution not yet perfected.

Example

- Dancers who dance more than 1 hour per week but are not in a competition troupe.
- Dancers who are new to a competitive troupe.
- Dancers who have some experience, less than 3 years.

COMPETITIF

Saturday night showcase

- Dancers with extensive competition experience (around 5 years) and who train for more than 5 hours per week.
- Dancers from evening studio troupes.
- Dancers from dance study programmes who are at the beginning of their training (e.g. secondary 1-2).

ELITE

Saturday night showcase

- Dancers with extensive experience, several years of competition and training.
- Dancers who receive several hours of training each week, such as dance studies or professional training.
- Dancers who have already appeared on television, had contracts, or performed outside of their studio.



IMPORTANT

TIMES ARE FOR GUIDANCE ONLY

Times are not listed according to individual disciplines but rather as a total for all students' training. Judges reserve the right to disqualify any group that is not in the correct level or dance style. They may also change categories themselves. Please note that a change in classification or dance style may result in exclusion from the showcase or category ranking (1st-2nd-3rd place).

GROUPS AND TIMING

Solo (1) 3 minutes maximum

Duo/Trio (2 ou 3) 3 minutes maximum

Small group (4 à 9) 4 minutes maximum

Large group (10 à 15) 4 minutes maximum

Production (16 et plus) 7 minutes maximum

The timing of each choreography will be monitored by Bravissimo. One point will be deducted for every 5 seconds over the time limit.



CATEGORIES [DANCE STYLES]

- CLASSICAL BALLET
- JAZZ / MODERN JAZZ Maximum of 4 acrobatic moves.
- LYRICAL Maximum of 4 acrobatic moves.
- HIP HOP FOUNDATIONS
- HIP HOP CHOREO
- CONTEMPORAIN Maximum of 3 acrobatic moves.
- FREE STYLE Tap dancing, musical theatre, or any style of dance that does not fit into the other categories.
- ACRO

ACCESSORIES

Accessories are permitted. If the accessory is of considerable size, it must be approved in advance by Bravissimo.

SCORING PROCEDURE

Competitors will be judged by a panel of at least three judges who are highly qualified in their respective disciplines. The judges' decision is final. It is forbidden to address the judges during the competition.

Each group will receive a grade based on its results.

STEP 2

A 3rd, 2nd and 1st place will be awarded in each style/age/group category.

STEP 3

Among all solo, duo, and trio choreographies (all dance styles combined), the choreography with the highest score will receive a cash prize.

STAGE 1

Each group will receive a mention based on their results. The judges will award special mentions to their favourites (costumes/performance, etc.). The judges will also award COUP DE FOUDRE mentions to breathtaking choreography!

STAGE 2

In each style/age category, 3rd, 2nd and 1st place will be awarded.

STAGE 3 SHOWCASES

Among all the coups de foudre in the **competitive and elite categories**, 15 will be chosen for the **SATURDAY EVENING** showcase.

The top 5 will receive a cash prize.

COMPETITION SCHEDULE

The weekend schedule will be sent to you approximately **6 weeks before the event**. The schedule for each category may vary from year to year.

GENERAL RULES

- Smoking, drinking, and eating are strictly prohibited in the competition hall.
- Participants authorise Bravissimo to use their photos/videos for promotional purposes.
- Video cameras and cameras are prohibited, with the exception of the Bravissimo team.
- Please keep your **mobile phone** or any other electronic device **turned off** in the competition hall.
- No participant will be allowed to practise in the competition hall.
- **Politeness and respect** towards staff, spectators and competitors **are required**. Failure to comply with this rule may result in disqualification and/or expulsion from the competition site, the event or the entire school.
- Bravissimo is **not responsible for** theft or **loss of items**.
- Competitors must keep the rehearsal rooms clean.
- The judges' scores are final.
- Knives, swords, or pyrotechnic equipment are prohibited.
- Arcanson is prohibited.
- Neutral lighting for all groups.
- Any act deemed inappropriate for the public (music/costumes/choreography) may be automatically disqualified.
