ELIGIBILITY

All dancers must be at the amateur level.

AGE

Classification is based on age at the time of the competition.

Our age groups: ages 6–9/ages 10–12/ages 13–15/16 and older/adults 25 and older.

For a group of more than one person, age is calculated based on the group's average.

- 9.5 and above = 10–12 years old
- 12.5 and above = 13–15 years old
- 15.5 and above = 16 years old and above

A dancer who is just starting out. Little or no experience in competition or performance. EXAMPLE: - Dancers who have never competed or have competed only once. - Beginner dancers with 1–2 years or less of experience. <i>For groups, we allow up to 25% of dancers who are at the next higher level to participate in the choreography.</i>	Dancers with little competition experience who are at the beginner level. Their technique and execution are not yet perfected. EXAMPLE: - A dancer who dances for more than 1 hour a week but is not part of a competitive troupe. - Dancers starting out in a competition troupe. - Dancers with some experience (less than 3 years). <i>For groups, we allow up to 25% of dancers who are at the next higher level to participate in the choreography.</i>	A dancer with extensive competition experience (about 5 years) who trains for more than 5 hours a week. Dancers from night studio troupes. Dancers in training programs that are in the early stages of their training (e.g., 7th–8th grade/secondary 1–2). <i>For groups, we allow up to 25% of dancers who are at the next higher level to participate in the choreography.</i>	- Highly experienced dancers with several years of competition and training. - Dancers who receive several hours of training each week in the form of dance workshops or professional training. Dancers who have previously appeared on TV, have contracts, or have performed outside of their studio. <i>For groups, we allow up to 25% of dancers who are at the next higher level to participate in the choreography.</i>

IMPORTANT

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TIMES ARE FOR REFERENCE PURPOSES ONLY

The times are not listed by individual discipline but rather as the students' total practice time. The judges reserve the right to disqualify any group that is not at the correct level or in the correct dance style.

GROUPS AND TIMING

Solo (1)	3 minutes maximum
Duo/Trio (2 ou 3)	3 minutes maximum
Small group (4 to 9)	4 minutes maximum
Large group (10 to 15)	4 minutes maximum
Production (16 and Above)	7 minutes maximum

Bravissimo will monitor the timing of each choreography. 1 point will be deducted every 5 sec overrun.



CATEGORIES (DANCE STYLES)

- CLASSICAL BALLET
- JAZZ Maximum of 4 tricks.
- LYRIQUE Maximum of 4 tricks.
- HIP HOP FOUNDATIONS
- HIP HOP CHOREO
- CONTEMPORARY Maximum of 4 tricks.
- FREESTYLE Tap dance, musical theater, or dance style that doesn't fit in the other categories
- ACRO

ACCESSORIES

Accessories are permitted.

If the accessory is particularly large, it must first be approved by Bravissimo.

SCORING PROCESS

Competitors will be judged by a panel of at least three judges who are highly qualified in their respective disciplines. The judges' decision is final. Competitors are prohibited from speaking to the judges during the competition.

A 3rd, 2nd, and 1st place will be awarded in each style/age/group category.

STEP 3

Of all the solo, duo, and trio choreographies (across all dance styles), the choreography with the highest score will receive a cash prize.

SATURDAY SHOWCASE

STEP 1

Each group will receive a recognition based on its performance. The judges will also present the “COUP DE FOUDRE” and “TALENT REPÉRÉ” recognitions to a breathtaking choreography or a special, promising talent.

STEP 2

In each style/age category, 3rd, 2nd, and 1st place prizes will be awarded.

STEP 3 THE SHOWCASES

From among all the “coups de foudre” in the Competitive and Elite categories, 15 will be selected for the **SATURDAY NIGHT** showcase.
The top 5 will receive a cash prize.

COMPETITION SCHEDULE

The weekend schedule will be sent to you approximately **6 WEEKS BEFORE THE EVENT**.
The schedule for each category may vary from one year to the next.

GENERAL RULES

- It is strictly **PROHIBITED** to eat or drink in the competition hall.
- Participants **authorize Bravissimo** to use their photos and videos for promotional purposes.
- For the safety and well-being of your dancers, cameras/video equipment are **PROHIBITED** except for the Bravissimo team.
- Please keep your phone or any other electronic device in **silent mode** in the competition hall.
- No participant** will be **allowed** to practise on stage before the competition.
- POLITENESS AND RESPECT** toward staff, spectators, and competitors are required. Any violation of this rule may result in disqualification and/or immediate expulsion.
- Bravissimo is not responsible for lost or stolen items.
- Competitors must **KEEP THE FITTING ROOMS CLEAN**. Any damage to the premises or equipment will be billed directly to the dance school.
- The judges' **score is final**, and it is prohibited to speak to the judges.
- Guns, knives, swords, and fireworks are **prohibited**.
- Rosin mixture is **prohibited**.
- Any performance deemed **inappropriate for the audience** (music, costumes, choreography) may be automatically **disqualified**.
